Any alteration to roofing material or color shall be approved in advance by the Architectural Review Committee (ARC). Roofing materials can be cedar shakes, tile, or "architectural grade" composition roofing, subject to approval of the ARC. The board has created a pre-approved list of composition roofing materials and colors for homeowners to choose from. Homeowners will still need to complete and submit an ARC-request, but the ARC will be able to approve in the shortest possible time if the homeowner chooses one of the materials and colors off the list.
